Lincoln Literacy is a private, nonprofit agency. Our volunteer teachers help people to understand, speak, read, and write English.



Our teachers will help you use English to:

- complete a job application
- take the test for your driver's license
- visit the doctor
- prepare for citizenship
- or continue your education

Getting Started

To become a student with us is easy.

First: You can come to our office on any Monday afternoon between 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. or to Bennett Martin Library on any Saturday afternoon between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. Please note that we do not provide this service during holidays. See the maps on next page for directions. If those days and times are not good for you, call Lincoln Literacy for an appointment.

Second: Our staff will ask you for some information about your goals, your family and your current address. Then they will test your English ability. Don't worry about the test. We help students at all levels, from beginning to advanced.

Third: Our staff will tell you about English classes you can take. Lincoln Literacy offers classes at many times and locations. *Some of our group classes offer free child-minding and transportation services.*

Fourth: You will start classes that run from September — December, and from January — May, with a summer session in June and July. You can start anytime. It is important to attend regularly and continue classes even if you get a job, so that you can master English.
